



EAST COAST APPLIQUE

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Pumpkin Coaster

Materials needed:

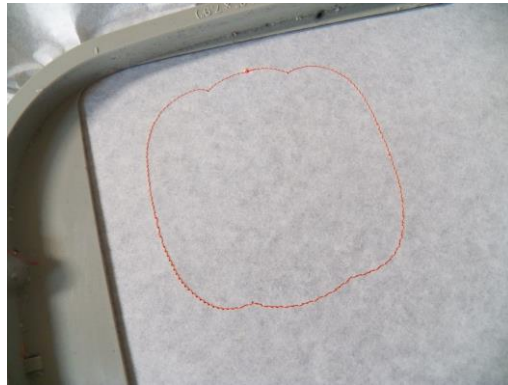
- *Tearaway stabilizer
- *Coordinating embroidery thread
- *Batting
- *2 Fabric panels measuring 5" x 5" folded in half and pressed to 2.5 x 5 inches
- *1 fabric panel measuring 4.5 x 4.5 inches
- *Tape and 505 adhesive spray

ribbon

*Water soluble solvy if desired

Directions

1. Hoop tearaway stabilizer. Run step one, which is your placement stitch. Spray 505 adhesive spray on back of batting and then place batting over the placement stitches.



2. Run step two, which is the tackdown stitch of the batting. Trim excess batting away to eliminate bulk later when turning in the manner as shown below with our elegant frame coaster.



3. Spray 505 Spray on the back side of 4.5 x 4.5 fabric panel. You now place the fabric panel down right side up (you should see your pretty fabric looking at you) and then run step three to secure fabric.



4. Run step four to add quilting. If you are adding a design or a monogram you will now insert that after quilting but before proceeding to the ribbon leaf and stem placement.



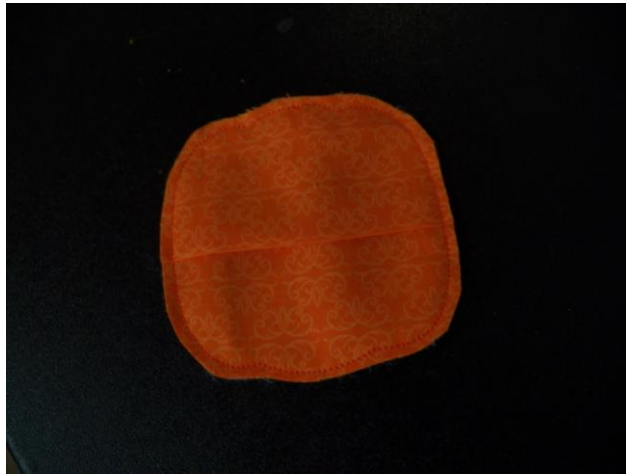
5. You will now run the placement stitch of the ribbon leaf and stem. Tape your ribbon stem and leaf in place much like the photo below. Take note that the stem and leaf need to be going in toward the center of the design so that when you turn your coaster it will flip up in the right direction. Run the tackdown stitch of the ribbon leaf and stem. You may now remove the tape.



6. Take one of the 2.5 x 5 fabric panels and place the fold slightly above the center of your coaster. Use tape to secure the sides. Place the second 2.5 x 5 fabric panel in the same manner with the fold slightly overlapping the previous one. Please take note of picture below.



7. Remove hoop from machine and coaster from Stabilizer. Trim around the edges, leaving at least a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam. Do not trim on your stitches. Turn the coaster on both ends. You may need to use a dull pointed object to push the ends out completely to get a nice pumpkin shape. Press with low heat.
